FROM FATHER MIKE

I hope you are as challenged as I am by today's first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, which describes the seemingly perfect community that was "of one heart and mind, and no one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they had everything in common." This communal support was such that "[t]here was no needy person among them." Now, in case you think this is too idealistic, the very next story in Acts shows a married couple, Ananias and Sapphira, selling their property but not sharing all the proceeds, yet they still sought accolades for their alleged generosity. Living life in common is always a challenge for Christians, and while at times difficult, it is never optional. As Catholics, we firmly believe that you are not an authentic Christian without being engaged in a community with other Christians. The Catholic version of this community is a parish, within which there are various smaller communities of support, study, and outreach. Engaging in this communal life means that, beyond showing up for Mass, a disciple of Jesus interacts with fellow parishioners. A way to increase the Easter effect in your life is to look at ways to become more engaged in Christ's Body of the church and in the lives of your sisters and brothers here at St. Anne Parish.

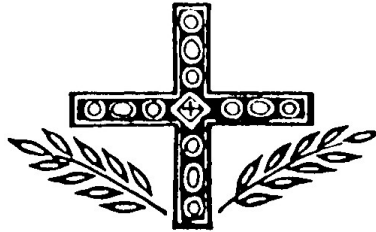

HOW TO REPORT AN INCIDENT OF SEXUAL ABUSE OF A MINOR

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- 1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556.
- 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.
- 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, P.O. Box 909, Lafayette, IN 47902.
- 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.
